SIXTH FORM ADMISSION 2025

Gunnersbury is a voluntary aided School under the trusteeship of the Archdiocese of Westminster (with girls admitted into the Sixth Form). We seek to provide a high quality education for all our pupils. It is essential that the Catholic character of the School's education be fully supported by all families in the school. All applicants are therefore expected to give their full, unreserved and positive support for the aims and ethos of the school.

The school is conducted by its governing body as part of the Catholic Church in accordance with its trust deed and instrument of government, and seeks at all times to be a witness to our faith.

In addition to places reserved for the School's own pupils, the governors propose to admit a minimum of 15 external students annually to its Sixth Form, provided that they meet the required, School determined, academic qualifications for their chosen course. The course entry requirements may be found within the prospectus packs. The School welcomes applications to the 6th Form from students, girls and boys, from other institutions.

Application must be made on the Sixth Form Application Form and an offer of a Sixth Form place is conditional on the school being able to provide a course suited to the applicant's age, ability, aptitude and educational needs. In the event of more applicants meeting the requirement for entry than places available the main school oversubscription categories and priorities will be invoked. SUBJECT ENTRY CRITERIA 2025

Students wishing to study 'A' levels will need to have achieved a GCSE grade of 4 in both English and Mathematics; as well as 3 other GCSE passes at Grade 4 or higher.

In addition, each subject has its own specific entry requirements as detailed below:

A Level Biology	Grade 6 in GCSE Biology PLUS Grade 6 in Maths or Grade 66 in GCSE Combined Science PLUS Grade 6 in Maths
A Level Business Studies	Grade 6 in GCSE Business Studies or Grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or Maths PLUS Grade 6 in one other subject
A Level Chemistry	Grade 6 in GCSE Chemistry PLUS Grade 6 in Maths or Grade 66 in GCSE Combined Science PLUS Grade 6 in Maths
A Level Computer Science	Grade 6 in GCSE Computer Science PLUS Grade 6 in Maths or Grade 7 in GCSE Maths
A Level Design & Technology	Grade 6 in a GCSE Design & Technology subject
A Level Economics	Grade 6 in GCSE Maths PLUS Grade 5 in GCSE English Language PLUS Grade 6 in one subject further to Maths (English may be included)
A Level English Literature	Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature or English Language
A Level French	Grade 6 in GCSE French
A Level Further Mathematics	Grade 8 in GCSE Maths; applicants must also study 'A' level Maths
A Level Geography	Grade 6 in GCSE Geography or Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or Grade 6 in Science PLUS Grade 6 in one other subject
A Level History	Grade 6 in GCSE History or Grade 6 in GCSE English Language or English Literature PLUS Grade 6 in one other subject
A Level Mathematics	Grade 7 in GCSE Maths
A Level Physics	Grade 6 in GCSE Physics PLUS Grade 6 in Maths or Grade 66 in GCSE Combined Science PLUS Grade 6 in Maths
A Level Politics	Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature or English Language PLUS Grade 6 in one other subject
A Level Psychology	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language PLUS Grade 5 in either GCSE Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Grade 55 in GCSE Combined Science PLUS Grade 6 in a subject further to English (Science may be included)
A Level Philosophy and Ethics (RE)	Grade 6 in GCSE RE
BTEC National Extended Diploma in Business or Sport	At least 5 GCSE passes at Grade 4 including Grade 4 in GCSE English or Grade 4 in GCSE Mathematics

Partner School A Level Options

- Through our partner schools students can study **Classical Civilisation, Italian, Spanish, Music, PE, Drama and Sociology**
- Entry requirement will be set by these schools – generally including a Grade 6 in the subject or a related subject
- Gunnersbury students do not usually study more than one 'partner-school' subject
