<p><u>Autumn</u> <u>Half</u> <u>Term 1</u></p> <p><u>Autumn</u> <u>Half</u> <u>Term 2</u></p>	<p><b><u>Objectives</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To explore skills in tone, watercolour, mixed media focussing on the work of European artists and observational drawing as a starting point.</li><li>• To explore a variety of mark making styles</li><li>• To explore forms of printmaking and sculpting using clay</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• An understanding of contextual studies and how this can be used as a springboard for developing your own creative ideas using a broad range of techniques</li><li>• Critique and discussion of best practise using visual exemplar, students own work and demonstration.</li><li>• To learn skills in the formal elements; composition, line, tone and shape</li><li>• To learn skills in painting and sculpture</li><li>• To learn how to present images in a sketchbook and on portfolio sheets for interview</li><li>• To learn how to create an independent exploration into an aspect of art, craft and design through a mini personal investigation in preparation for year 13 unit 1</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Through use of sketchbook. Each page is marked with feedback and an overall grade is given based on evidence seen within the work</li><li>• Through use of portfolio sheets. A mark is given based on evidence seen within the work</li><li>• Verbal feedback, self and peer assessment is on going throughout the project</li></ul>
