# Year 10 English

## Exploration of language – fiction

Students read a range of fiction from writers including Khaled Hosseini, Susan Hill and Terry Pratchett; a focus on how writers use language and structure for impact,

## Revision of Macbeth

Weekly revision tasks on the novella with a focus on themes and structure of the text. Students will practise how to approach exam questions.

## Exploration of language - nonfiction

Students read a range of nonfiction from writers of the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> C including Charlotte Bronte, Charles Darwin and Jane Austen; diary entries, speech transcripts and essays. Focus on rhetorical devices.

## Assessment

Analysis and comparison of non fiction writing. Macbeth exam question

This will focus on the style of exam questions and building confidence in context.
