You will develop your own drawings alongside your artist research to inspire you to create a series of lino cut prints and paintings using acrylic paint



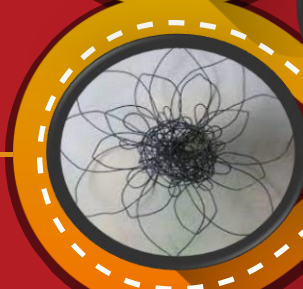
Collage
