<p><u>Autumn Half Term 1 (then repeated Spring half term 2)</u></p>	<p>Year 8 students study Art & Design for a term and a half and have a total of one double lesson per week. In Year 8, students will build upon their knowledge from Year 7, broadening their understanding of Art & Design through a programme of study that encourages students to explore and experiment further with their ideas and to develop imaginative outcomes. Students will develop craft skills working in two and three-dimensions using materials such as card, wire, paint and paper manipulation.
