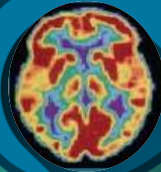




# Year 13 Psychology

## Biopsychology

Students focus on the key biological processes that govern our thoughts, behaviours and attitudes e.g. the brain



## Assessment 1

Assessment based on all Year 12 content



## Stress

The students focus on main explanations for stress as well as looking at ways of managing stress



## Gender

Students study the biology behind the experience of being male or female as well as consider how and why gender can be experienced differently by some



## Aggression

Students study the key explanations behind why we might behave aggressively



## Assessment 2

Assessment based on a combination of Year 12 and all of the newer Year 13 topic areas



## Research Methods

Students will build on their knowledge of how to conduct research and to consider increasingly complex issues and styles of analysing data



## Issues and Debates

Students recap texts studied so far this year



## Assessment 3

Students will be assessed on every topic area covered on the course, similar to the 'real' exam



## Revision

Intervention and support will be given for each topic area in lesson/ additional lessons until the exams
