# Year 7 History

## Boudicca's Revolt

How successful were the Ancients? Students will study the Ancient Greeks and Ancient Romans; they will look at lifestyle and survival. They will study the development of Roman Britain and in particular look at the battle between Boudicca and the Romans



## Writing tasks- throughout the year

Students have key pieces of work which are deep marked and then returned to students with time made to allow time for re-drafting (TRIO)



## The Norman Conquest

How successful was the Norman Conquest of England? Students will look at the fight for the throne in the 11th century and debate the characteristics of a good monarch. Students will then proceed to study the changes brought about by William the Conqueror, both socially and religiously



## Assessment

The focus will be writing a chronological account of how the Normans were able to win the battle of Hastings. Students will have to reach a judgment.



## The Church and its impact on life in the middle ages

Christianity in England in the Middle Ages Identifying the role religion played in Medieval England. Students will study how religion played a role in every day life and impacted all areas, such as medicine through the black death.



## Power in medieval Britain

How did the Magna Carta limit the power of the King and What was the role of Parliament



Did the people become more powerful than the King?

## The Tudors

Students will enquire about what was life like in Tudor England?

What was a young Henry VII like

Who were the other Tudor monarchs?

Tudor portraits and their symbolism



## Assessment

Students will be assessed on their ability to write like a historian and use historical sources, as well as key aspects of knowledge which will be assessed.
