## Causes of WWI

Students will cover the MAIN causes of WW1. As well as looking at the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand and the short term spark.



## Writing tasks- throughout the year

## The changing nature of warfare

What was warfare like prior to World War One? Fighting in the War & Trench/Warfare What was the Schlieffen Plan?



## Battles of WW1

What was Life in the trenches like. How did warfare change due to the Weapons of WWI. How did this impact Battles of WWI? What was the role of Soldiers of the empire

## Assessment

Assessments will ask students to use their judgment skills to decide what some of the greatest changes to warfare were made during WW1, for example through the use of technology



## The outbreak of WWII

Why did WWII break out and how had warfare changed since WW1. Students will look at the Battle of Britain, Dunkirk and other key turning points in the war.

## Life in Nazi Germany

Students will study how civilians were effected by the laws imposed by Hitler. They will also study the holocaust and the systematic persecution of the Jews in Nazi Germany.



## Assessment

Students will have to make judgments and write narrative accounts of significant events and turning points covered throughout the year.
