Start:

Who am I?

Students study vocabulary and key verbs to give basic information about themselves and opinions.



Modular Assessment

Throughout the year, students undertake Reading, Listening Writing or Speaking exams, based on the content they have just covered.



School Life

Students engage with discussing their hobbies, the dangers of the online realm and contemporary TV and film



Culture

Students explore the difference between French and English schools, sports in francophone countries, and Bastille Day.



Free Time

Students are able to give an opinion on sports and hobbies, linking it to the weather. A grammar focus is on indefinite and partitive articles.



Family Life

Pupils acquire vocabulary and structures linked to family, pets and home. They revisit the partitive article and the formation of 'er' verbs.



Review

In May half term, year 7 will revisit key vocabulary and grammar points to ensure full retention of knowledge in preparation for year 8.



End of year assessment

This exam covers modules 1-4 and assesses vocabulary and grammar knowledge through listening, reading and writing skills.



My Town

In this final module, year 7 use town vocabulary to discuss where they go, inviting others out, and ordering food. They are also introduced to the near future tense.



Speaking practice

Students will use their knowledge of French vocabulary, sound patterns and grammar taught in modules 1-5 to practise their speaking skills
