



Start:

Year 8 French

Vive les vacances

Students study how to talk about their holidays. They will be studying how to say what they did during their holidays and how to describe their last visit to a theme park.



Modular assessment

Throughout the year, students undertake Reading, Listening Writing or Speaking exams, based on the content they have just covered



J'adore les fêtes

Students study how to talk about celebrations around the world. They will be studying how to describe what is their favourite celebrations and what happens during.



Culture

We will discuss celebration in the French speaking world and students will be able to discover more about different customs and beliefs. Culture points will be incorporated in all modules.



A loisir

Students study how to talk about their hobbies. We will focus on digital technology and their favourite TV programs. They will also learn to talk about going out with their friends at the cinema and in shops.



Grammar

Students will start by revising a wide range of adjectives and the correct adjectival agreements before moving to asking and answering questions in 3 tenses (perfect, present and near future)



Le monde est petit

Students study how to talk about where they live and their area. They will also learn to talk about their daily routine and what they do to help at home.



End of year exam

Students will be assessed on 3 skills: Reading, Listening and Writing.



Module 5

Students study how to express themselves on the sports they live and dislike. They will also learn to talk about injuries and illness related to the practice of sport.



Speaking

Before the end of the year students will combine their knowledge and revise all modules in order to practice speaking skills. A speaking exam will be held as a preparation for their GCSE.
