Year 10 French

Le temps libre

Students engage with discussing their hobbies, the dangers of the online realm and contemporary TV and film



Modular Assessment

At least once a Module, students undertake Reading, Listening and/or Speaking and Writing exams, based on the content they have just covered

Les vacances

Students discuss countries, regions, transport, accommodation, holiday activities, holiday problems and weather conditions



Assessment

Students are assessed on the 2 previous modules through Listening, Reading and Speaking.

La technologie

Students learn how to describe online activities, the pros and cons of social media and technology, cyberbullying. They also discuss how technology has changed over time and what the future holds.

Students study how to describe where they live, what there is/is not and what can be done in their town. Students also learn how to describe their ideal town.

Customs and festivals

In the final module, students will learn about customs and festivals in French-speaking countries.
