Start:

School

Students study vocabulary about transport, school facilities, timetable, daily routine, school rules and comparing with primary school



Assessment

Students are assessed on all the previous modules through Listening, Reading and Writing.



Future aspiration and work

Students study how to talk their plans for the future. They will learn about careers and be study how to talk about what they want to do in the future.



Assessment

Having now covered all but 2 modules, students will undertake an in-depth Mock exam covering all GCSE topics studied thus far



Environment and Social/Global issues

Students engage with recognising social as well as global issues and protecting the planet.



Customs and festivals

In the final module, students will learn about customs and festivals in French-speaking countries.



Revision and preparation

Students start revising vocabulary on all GCSE modules, through reading, listening and writing. They will also practise the different elements of the speaking exam.



Speaking Exam

After Easter, students will sit their speaking exams. Before that, they will revise expressions they wish to use, and work on their topic of presentation and follow-up questions



Writing, Listening & Reading preparation

Students will continue to revise topic specific vocabulary and the skills needed to do well in the different exams



GCSE

Students will be assessed on the 3 remaining skills: Reading, Listening and Writing.
