Students consider the benefits of living in an ethnically diverse society and how we can promote diversity to create a richer world

Assessment

Based on 2 modules. Students undertake Reading, Listening, writing and speaking exam

La politique et l'immigration

Students will discuss some of the political issues and solutions regarding immigration in francophone countries.

L'étranger

Students read the philosophical book by Albert Camus and learn how to write a critical analysis of the different themes and characters

Speaking Exam

After Easter, students will sit their speaking exams. This will consist of questions on their Independent Research Projects and a discussion about one of the other topic seen at A level.

Students examine different groups who are socially marginalised

Students examine different attitudes to crime and consider alternative forms of punishment

Students learn and discuss arguments relating to the vote and examine the French political system and its evolution

Students learn and discuss the important role of unions in France and French-speaking countries

A level exam
