



It is my pleasure to introduce the Gunnersbury Catholic School Sixth Form prospectus.

The aim of this publication is to capture what is special about our school. Our Sixth Form provides a truly outstanding education for young men and women in West London and beyond. Gunnersbury has an excellent record of success in public examinations and academic standards are exceptionally high; our A level results regularly place us amongst the top state schools in the country with the majority of our students continuing their studies at top universities. Our senior students are high achieving and successful and, for the last 13 years, our 'A' Level pass rate has been 100%, with students securing grades A* and A well above the national average. Gunnersbury Sixth Formers go on to study at Oxford, Cambridge, Imperial College, UCL, York, Durham, King's College and St Andrews, to name a few.

Learning is not restricted to the classroom and students will gain valuable experience from the many subject specific visits that are a key element of the Sixth Form experience at Gunnersbury.





THE AQUINAS PROGRAMME

St. Thomas Aquinas, one of the greatest and most influential theologians of all time, is patron of all universities and of students. Inspired by Aquinas' work, we offer a bespoke programme of support that is open to all Sixth Formers who aspire to leading universities such as Oxford or Cambridge University, or to a career in medicine, dentistry or veterinary medicine.

Oxford and Cambridge look for candidates with a background in academically rigorous subjects; students who have had educational opportunities that have stretched them beyond the exam board specifications. The Aquinas Programme has been designed to do just that, to nurture our most able young men and women and to enable them to reach their potential in their chosen field.

OCTOBER TERM OF YEAR 13

The Aquinas Programme complements the academic rigour of our 'A' Level courses; it seeks to empower participants to be confident, articulate, questioning and passionate about their studies. Those who participate will be guided and encouraged throughout the year by school staff and will receive expert tuition and support from colleagues working in some of the best universities.

Students will join the programme in their first week of Year 12. Aspects of this special programme will involve:

In addition, all Gunnersbury Sixth Formers will receive extensive careers and university advice throughout Years 12 and 13. This includes guest speakers and individual support to assist with the university planning process and writing an effective application.





All Year 12 students contribute to our well established Community Volunteering programme which supports the school and local communities. Gunnersbury has a long and proud tradition as a rugby school and our First XV squads enjoy a great record at inter-school and county level. The senior rugby squads regularly tour outside of the UK. Many of our students compete at county and national level across a wide range of disciplines, including track and field, judo and rowing. We are proud to number amongst our alumni Commonwealth champions and professional athletes. All of our BTEC Extended Diploma Sport and Exercise students work each year to gain the Young Sports Leader Award

Experienced and budding orators can enjoy our Senior Debating Society, supported by the Catenians, the Jack Petchey Foundation and the Rotary Club of Great Britain.

A strong and effective Prefect Team are led by our Lead Sixth Formers who support school leaders in managing the Sixth Form Centre and working as mentors with students in lower years on the School Council and in Form Groups. Prefects also plan a range of team building events throughout the year, including sports competitions, fund raising activities and Black History Month celebrations, to name a few.

Completed applications, including the references, must be returned by Friday, 26 January 2024 to


