Students focus on conformity, conformity to social roles, obedience, minority influence and social change

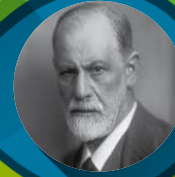


Assessment 1

Attachment

Students to look at explanations of early childhood attachment as well as look at research into the attachment process

Psychopathology

To discuss definitions of psychological disorders, as well as to look in particular at the characteristics, explanations and treatments of Phobias, Depression and OCD
